Sean "The Mayor" Casey had an unbelievable career on the field and his legacy off the field continues to grow each year through his continued involvement in the game of baseball and his charitable work.

Cleveland was where he was drafted and recorded his first career MLB hit. Cincinnati is where his career took off, eventually becoming a Reds Hall of Famer. Pittsburgh was his hometown team, and the hometown boy came home. Detroit embraced him as he led them to a World Series appearance in 2006. Lastly, Boston ended with him hitting .322, solidifying his place in MLB history as one of the best hitters of all-time with a career mark over .300.

#### **Miracle League Participants**

#### Age Limits

There are no age limits!

Parents of attending athletes must assist with organizing, fundraising and planning the trip.

#### **Participation Fee:**

\$750 Per Player (estimate, could be lower depending on fundraising efforts by family and Miracle League.)

- \$250 deposit to be paid in April.
- Remaining \$500 to be paid before the trip (date TBD).
